USB Wi-Fi Router Repeater

Wireless setup instructions for tablets, smartphones, and laptops

Important! - Before you power the router up...

Assemble the USB Wi-Fi antenna and fix it in position outside your caravan or boat. Connect the antenna to the USB port on the USB Wi-Fi repeater, then power it up.

Switch on the USB Wi-Fi repeater

- Scan for Wi-Fi networks with your tablet, smartphone, or laptop. You will see an open network **11N 3G Router_AP**
- Connect to this network it will not require a security key.

Open your browser (Chrome, Firefox, Safari, Internet Explorer, etc)

- Type **192.168.2.1** into the address bar of your browser and then press enter.
- You will get an 'Authentication Required' box To log in, the Username is admin and the Password is also admin

Now click the 'Easy Setup' tab

- Select **USB Wireless Adapter** and then click on **Site Survey** on the next screen.
- Click the dot next to the Wi-Fi network name (**SSID**) you want to join, for example '*Free WiFi SiteName*' and then click the **Select** button.
- If it is a secure network, on the following page you will be required to enter a 'Pass Phrase' for your choice under the **Security Policy** heading and click **Next** (*This is the Wi-Fi password for the chosen network*)
- If it is an open network on the next screen you will see **Security Mode** set to **Disable**. If so, simply click the **Next** button to proceed.

Now to setup your own internal Wi-Fi hotspot and make it secure

- In **SSID Choice** enter the name you want the router to broadcast e.g. 'My WiFi Hotspot'.
- We advise to set the Security Mode from the dropdown box to WPA2-PSK and the WPA Algorithms to AES
- For the **Pass Phrase** use a minimum of 8 characters e.g. 'P4ssw0rd'.
- Click the **Done** button.
 - You will now lose your Wi-Fi connection to the router and the page on the browser will appear to freeze. Do not worry, as you can now close your browser window.

Wait for a minute or so...

- Now search for and choose 'My WiFi Hotspot' (or whatever name you used) in the Wi-Fi network list of the device you are using, then join the network by using the password you created during the configuration.
- Open your browser again and you should now find that you have access to the web (however you may be re-directed to log-in page if the WiFi network uses a ticket/token system which will also apply if the WiFi network is an open type)

Troubleshooting

- Type **192.168.2.1** into the address bar of your browser again and then enter the Username and Password. Check whether the **Status** page says you are connected. If not click on **Change Profile** and re-select a network.
- If you are having problems connecting to **BT Fon** or **OpenZone** please visit http://www.solwise.co.uk/downloads/files/troubleshooting-the-usb-wifi-router-and-fon-networks.pdf
- Using **`Forget This Network**' or similar on your WiFi device settings (tablets, etc...) can relieve connections that appear to be stuck this results from multiple configuration attempts where underlying settings change on the USB WiFi Router.
- To default the unit back to factory settings, press and hold the **red reset button** on the bottom of it for approximately **5 seconds** and then release.
